

Dear Customer,

The redevelopment of the former Sylvania Guest House site requires us to excavate part of La Rue de la Haule, as indicated on the enclosed map, over two forthcoming weekends to enable us to connect a new electricity supply.

One lane of the road will remain open throughout the period of works. However due to the high volume of traffic on this road and the lack of a feasible diversion route, the Environmental Health Department has given us permission to work outside normal hours and carry out 'Noisy Works' until 10pm and 'quiet works' until 2am on the dates detailed below.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause you but assure you the works will be carried out as quickly and efficiently as possible. Details are follows:

Stage One Friday 20 January: starting at approximately 7pm, carry out a road crossing from the boundary of the Sylvania site to the white line in the middle of La Rue de la Haule. The road will be reinstated and fully open to traffic by 6:30am the following morning, Saturday 21 January.

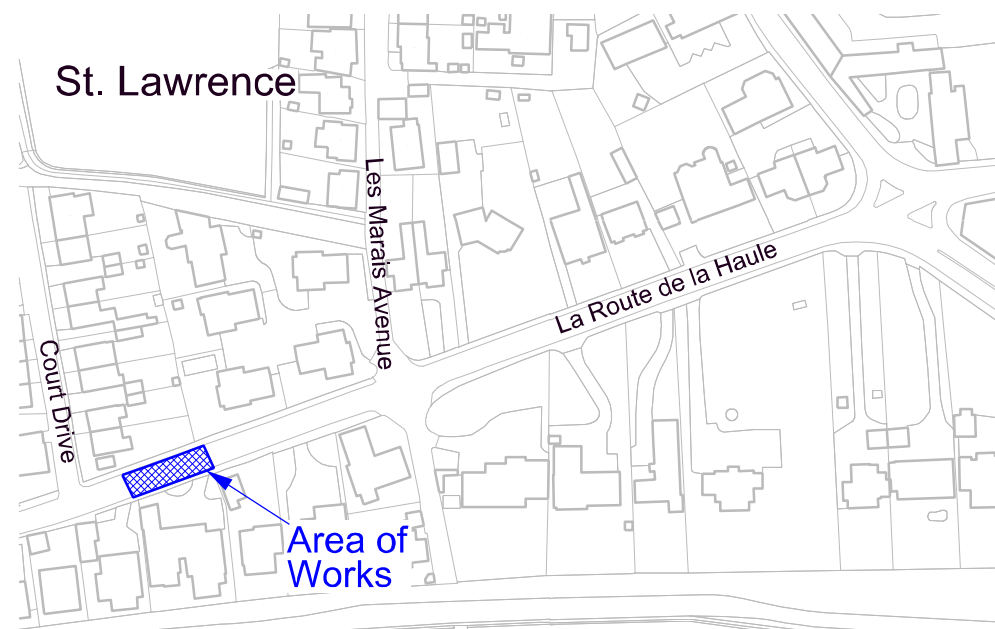
Stage Two Friday 27 January: starting at approximately 7pm and continuing throughout the weekend, excavate pits and start jointing cable onto our existing network. The road will be reinstated and fully open to traffic by 6.30am Monday 30 January.
