We are writing to inform you about planned roadworks and upgrades to the electricity infrastructure in your area. We are coordinating with our partners at government who are completing works on Bagatelle Road and Mont Millais to minimise disruption.

- Parish of St Helier: Parish Hall, Magistrate's Room, 6 July, 14:00 - 19:30
- Parish of St Saviour: Parish Hall, 9 July, 14:00 - 19:30

Details of the planned roadworks, Ref WO889842:

- Start Date: **Thursday 20 July 2026**, work will commence at 4am to ensure the site is set up properly and that all works are completed within the specified timeframe. We appreciate that this is a very early start but due to the nature of the works it is necessary to prepare the site for a prompt start.
- End Date: **Friday 4 September 2026**
- Location: St Saviour's Road, St Helier, between Simon Place and Brooklyn Street
- Purpose of the Roadworks: This closure is due to excavation works required in advance of resurfacing works on St Saviour's Road, to future proof our network in the area. This investment into our infrastructure is essential to enhance the reliability and efficiency of our electricity supply system.

All businesses on and around St Saviour's Road will operate as usual.
