**BEFORE** erecting scaffolding or putting up a ladder to work within three metres of an overhead power line you MUST contact Jersey Electricity to arrange for us to check the installation.

This applies to **ALL** overhead mains cables, whether they are supplying your individual property or running alongside your property, supplying other customers.

### B. INCOMING SERVICE CABLE AND METERING EQUIPMENT

It is **IMPORTANT** to be aware of the position of **ALL** service cables and associated metering equipment coming into your home and you must **NOT** interfere with this equipment under any circumstances.
